

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SATURDAY, MAY 14TH, A.D.1921, 11 A.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann, Wright. Absent, Lambert.

At this meeting, the Commissioners having completed the canvass of the returns of the regular City Election, held May 10, 1921, as recorded on pages 82 and 83 of the Book of Election returns, Commissioner Coy offered the following resolution which was adopted by unanimous vote of the Mayor and Commissioners present:

RESOLUTION

770-1307. BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio have this day canvassed the returns of a regular City Election held on the 10th day of May, 1921, and have made report thereon, and

WHEREAS, it has been found that the election was held and conducted, and the returns and canvass thereof made as provided by law, and the Commissioners having found said returns and said report in all respects correct, said report is hereby adopted, and it is ordered that the candidates who have received the highest number of votes cast in said election for their respective offices, as shown by said returns and canvass made this day, be and they are hereby declared elected, and that certificate of election be issued to each of them as by Law provided.

WHEREUPON the meeting adjourned.
