

AN ORDINANCE 2012-01-19-0042

AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF MANN WEIMER WAY AND MOZLEY RISE TO WEIMER WAY BETWEEN RANDOLPH BOULEVARD AND THE INTERSECTION OF EAST QUEENS CROWN, WEST QUEENS CROWN, AND POMEROY CIRCLE LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 10, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, in order to simplify traffic patterns, enhance public safety, improve emergency response times, and minimize public confusion, City Councilman John Clamp initiated and City Councilman Carlton Soules coordinated and revised this street renaming City Council request; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department staff was tasked with implementing this request through the street renaming process as required by the Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, this request was forwarded to and reviewed by all City of San Antonio Departments and outside agencies and no opposition was identified; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted a technical review of the proposed street name change finding it to conform to City Code requirements for renaming of public streets; and

WHEREAS, notice of this request to rename said streets was properly posted at City Hall, mailed to affected property owners, and disseminated through public service announcements, the notice requirements for renaming streets has been satisfied in accordance with Chapter 6 of the City Code and further, one written opposition and one written support has been received to the name change from affected property owners; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the Planning Commission was held on December 14, 2011 allowing all interested persons to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission approved a motion to support the street name change of Mann Weimer Way and Mozley Rise to Weimer Way; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The city-owned streets known as Mann Weimer Way and Mozley Rise located in City Council District 10 between Randolph Boulevard and the intersection of East Queens Crown, West Queens Crown, and Pomeroy Circle is hereby renamed Weimer Way. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited per the table below.



The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.




