

061 ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY CONDITIONS

The terms in the Supplementary Conditions will have the same meaning as in the 085 General Conditions for Heavy/Highway Construction Contracts (9/12/08 Rev.)

SC-3.4.3 Make the following modifications to 3.4 *Labor and Material*

- A. Delete Paragraph 3.4.3 of the General Conditions in its entirety and insert the following in its place:

“3.4.3 Except as otherwise required for safety or protection of persons or the Work or property at the Site or adjacent thereto, Work will be allowed by Owner as a twenty four (24) hour per day operation Monday 6:00 a.m. thru Saturday 11:00 p.m. unless directed by the ODR or requested in writing by Contractor and approved by the Director of Capital Improvements Management Services or its Designee Department Director. A minimum of Twelve (12) working hours per day will be required for this Project.”

SC-8.1.4 Make the following modifications to 8.1 *Definitions*.

- A. Delete Paragraph 8.1.4 of the General Conditions in its entirety and insert the following in its place:

“8.1.4 Day. The term “day” as used in the Contract Documents shall mean twenty four (24) hours per day Monday thru Saturday. A Calendar Day is a day of 24 hours measured from midnight to the next midnight, unless otherwise specifically stipulated. A Working Day is a day of twelve (12) hours as measured from midnight to the next midnight Monday thru Saturday.”

SC-8.2.4 Make the following modifications to 8.2 *Progress and Completion*.

- A. Delete Paragraph 8.2.4 of the General Conditions in its entirety and insert the following in its place:

“8.2.4 Work on Sundays may be permitted if Contractor gives City’s “COI” and City’s Project Manager at least the prerequisite forty-eight (48) hours written notice of intent to perform work on Sunday so that Owner’s representative may be scheduled to observe/inspect said work. Work on Sundays or holidays will not be permitted except in cases of extreme emergency and then only with the written permission of the City’s Project Manager.”

The following supplementary conditions will apply to the Broadway Corridor Phase IIIA (Carnahan) project.

SC-CPS *CPS Energy Approved Contractor Requirements*

- A. Contractor used for the CPS Energy electrical duct bank must have performed electrical duct bank work previously of similar technical scope and magnitude as the services to be performed under this contract. With their bid, Contractor shall provide evidence of qualifications in this regard and of any licenses, permits or registrations possessed that pertain to the services or are required in the specifications. Contractors may contact CPS Energy (CPS) prior to the letting of this project to determine if their previous experience meets this requirement. The approved list of CPS Energy approved subcontractors are provided below. Contractor to verify that the approved subcontractors below meet the required requirements prior to letting.
