**AMENDMENT #3, September 12, 2011**

Amendment #3 includes revisions to RFP.

**I. REVISIONS TO THE RFP**

1. Exhibit 2, Price Proposal Form is amended to include the following line item:

**“E.9.25 TRUCK STANDBY CHARGES”**

A revised Exhibit 2, Price Proposal Form dated 091211 has been uploaded to the website.

2. Exhibit 3, Description of Work Activities (Pay Items) is amended to include the following:

**Pay Item E.9.25**

**This unit price item shall include all costs related to truck standby time for trucks that are not loaded in a timely manner due construction issues or unforeseen conditions at the project site. Standby time will begin two (2) hours after the truck has arrived to the project site. It will be the Contractor’s responsibility to notify the City’s representative and provide written documentation. City will not consider any standby charges that are not approved by the City’s representative within 24 hours of the incident.**

A revised Exhibit 3, Description of Work Activities (Pay Items) dated 091211 has been uploaded to the website.

3. Section II, SCOPE OF WORK, DELIVERY ORDERS on page 3 of the RFP that reads:

The selected Contractor will be verbally notified of the proposed scope of work. At such time, the selected Contractor will meet with a City representative, inspect the proposed work site and discuss the specific scope of work for each proposed delivery order. The selected Contractor will submit a written cost estimate proposal to City representative based on the Contract Unit Prices, as established in the Price Proposal Form contained herein. Only the applicable Unit Prices submitted on this form shall be considered in developing the cost estimate. City will review and approve the cost estimate prior to releasing a delivery order. Each line item identified on the Price Proposal Form shall be independent from the other line items. All costs, equipment, labor, profit and overhead shall be included in the Unit Price for each line item to complete the work. The selected Contractor shall use only those line items necessary to fulfill a particular task order. Any cost or scope of work discrepancies shall be corrected and agreed upon by City and selected Contractor prior to releasing the task order. The selected Contractor

shall not proceed with the work activities until Contractor receives written documentation approving the scope of work and the total project cost.

Has been amended to read as follows:

The selected Contractor will be verbally notified of the proposed scope of work. At such time, the selected Contractor will meet with a City representative, inspect the proposed work site and discuss the specific scope of work for each proposed delivery order. The selected Contractor will submit a written cost estimate proposal to City representative based on the Contract Unit Prices, as established in the Price Proposal Form contained herein. Only the applicable Unit Prices submitted on this form shall be considered in developing the cost estimate. City will review and approve the cost estimate prior to releasing a delivery order. Each line item identified on the Price Proposal Form shall be independent from the other line items. All costs, equipment, labor, **payment and performance bonds**, profit and overhead shall be included in the Unit Price for each line item to complete the work. The selected Contractor shall use only those line items necessary to fulfill a particular task order. Any cost or scope of work discrepancies shall be corrected and agreed upon by City and selected Contractor prior to releasing the task order. The selected Contractor shall not proceed with the work activities until Contractor receives written documentation approving the scope of work and the total project cost.

4. Exhibit 1, Contract Document Template has now been uploaded to the website.
