

La Zona Cultural – Westside Cultural Corridors Bus Shelter Public Art Project

The City of San Antonio (Office of Cultural Affairs, Public Art San Antonio, Planning Department), in partnership with the VIA Metropolitan Transit Authority, are releasing a **Call for Artists** to solicit proposals seeking a professional public art design team consisting of a qualified professional artist and an architect, landscape architect, civil engineer, or equivalent designer, to submit one conceptual design proposal for new bus shelters that can be adapted to existing or planned VIA bus stop locations within the city's Westside Cultural Corridors area.

The design approach for this project should include a unifying aesthetic or theme that evokes the character and heritage of the surrounding neighborhood and creates visual markers along its cultural corridors. Each of the four bus stop locations should be considered as a site-specific opportunity to create a unique design; however, all of the bus shelters considered should maintain design consistency and complement the corridors.

Funds are available for the design and construction of four (4) bus shelters in this phase. Additionally, the Guadalupe Street Bond Savings Project includes the opportunity for additional bus stop enhancements within the Cultural Corridors project area.

Option A: Guadalupe Street at Colorado Intersection (VIA Bus Stop #14313) (SW corner of Street next to JT Brackenridge Academy; may have add'l SAISD requirements)



**Option B: Guadalupe Street at Colorado Intersection (VIA Bus Stop #14229)
(NE corner of Street next to Ruben's Ice House)**



Option C: Guadalupe Street just east of Brazos (VIA Bus Stop #13249)



**Option D: Brazos Street just south of Guadalupe (VIA Bus Stop #13246)
(Adjacent to JT Brackenridge Academy; may have add'l SAISD requirements)**



Option E: on Guadalupe Street just west of San Jacinto (VIA Bus Stop #12289) (adjacent to Primera Iglesia Church)



Option F: Brazos Street north of Lanier in traffic island (VIA Bus Stop #93257)
