I. QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS TO RFQ

1. The conflict of interest form is confusing. Who do I name as the Officer that I doing business with?
Response: The name of the Officer is the City official of whom you have a conflict of interest with. If you do not have a conflict of interest, then state "not applicable".
2. If we receive a commission will we be required to buy insurance for years before the commission is complete? If there are changes to an approved design that has gone through the approval process, will we be compensated for the extra work?
Response: Artists will only need insurance during the duration of their contract with the City. Artists will not need insurance just to be in the Artist pool.
3. I do not have time to write proposals, but I would like to be considered for future public sculpture commissions. Can I provide my website where you can see my public sculptures? Let me know if you need anything else with my website, resume and artist statement.
