

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

FRIDAY, MARCH 28th, A. D. 1924, 10 A. M.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Steffler, Wright.

Mayor Tobin, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Steffler, Wright.

AN ORDINANCE.

Appropriating \$500.00 Dollars to pay the expense of T. D. Cobbs and others to St. Louis and return.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of five hundred or as much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1923 general fund contingencies, to defray the expense of T. D. Cobbs, I. Ewig, and Hans Helland to St. Louis, Mo. and return, for the purpose of representing the City of San Antonio in its claim against Equitable Surety Company of New York, for the cost of maintenance of certain streets, under various maintenance bonds.

Mayor Tobin, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Steffler, Wright.

AN ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Madison Square, in the City of San Antonio, was heretofore designated as the site for the municipal auditorium now in contemplation of erection by the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, thereafter, Ralph H. Cameron, an architect of San Antonio, Texas, prepared certain preliminary plans of said auditorium with reference to the erection thereof on said Madison Square; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio have found it impracticable and impossible to construct said auditorium on Madison Square, or according to said preliminary plans of said Cameron, and have deemed it for the best interests of the City to change the location and plans, have therefore decided to exercise their option to change the location and the plans heretofore submitted, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,

1. That any and all ordinances designating said Madison Square as the site for said municipal auditorium be and the same are hereby repealed.

2. That the services of the said Ralph H. Cameron, Architect, are no longer required by the City of San Antonio, and the engineer thereof; and any agreement purporting to have been heretofore made with the said Ralph H. Cameron be and the same is hereby revoked and nullified.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
