

AN ORDINANCE      2011-03-10-0202

**AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF UP TO \$556,483.00, UPON AWARD, FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE GRANT PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2011, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2012; AND AUTHORIZING AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$321,307.00 AND A CASH MATCH OF \$300,000.00.**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has grant funds of as much as \$556,483.00 for the Comprehensive Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP); and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of said program is to combat the incidence of DWI and DWI related crashes through enforcement and education of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant period is October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, an in-kind matching contribution of \$321,307.00 and a cash matching contribution of \$300,000.00 are required; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to authorize the submission of a grant application for the aforementioned grant and acceptance of the grant, if awarded; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit a grant application in an amount not to exceed \$556,483.00 to the TxDOT for funding for the DWI STEP. In connection therewith, an in-kind matching contribution of \$321,307.00 and a cash matching contribution of \$300,000.00 are hereby authorized. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Fund 26059000 (TxDOT) is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. Should funding be awarded, the amounts set out above shall be appropriated in said fund. A final budget shall be submitted upon award.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer (CFO), City of San Antonio. The CFO may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific cost centers, WBS elements, internal orders, general ledger accounts, and fund numbers, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, provided that it is passed by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.





