----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition of V. Ligon and Co. for permit to build and run an amusement park at 421-429 Houston Street, was read and referred to Building Inspector.

Petition of Jno. J. Stevens to have tax levied to pay off judgement against City of San Antonio was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Petition of Commercial State Bank for refund of taxes was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Appropriating \$25,000.00 to construct sanitary sewer Pumping Station.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund for the purpose of constructing Sanitary Sewer Pumping Station at the corner of Sherman and Walter Streets.

Presa Street. in and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and description and drawings prepared and submitted by City Plumbing Inspector.

Section 2. That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, the sum of Forty One Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund.

An ordinance accepting proposal of Union Engineering Company for dismantling the S. Flores Street Bridge and authorizing contract and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. (Acceptance) That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposal of said party named in caption hereof, dated July 19, 1917 and offering to dismantle S. Flores Street bridge in and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and descriptions and drawings prepared and submitted by City Engineer provided said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this ordinance and all instruments herein referred to, which are made a part hereof

Section 2. (Contract etc.) That the Mayor is hereby authorized to cause and require

the execution and delivery of a written contract to be drawn in accordance with said proposal, and the terms and conditions understood and required as applicable to said matter.

Section 3. (Appropriation) That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund.

MB-723 AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Mayor to dispose of old horses and junk in the Fire Department.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

Sec. 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to dispose of any and all old and crippled horses now in possession of the Fire Department and who in the opinion of the Fire Chief are not capable of rendering further good service in that department.

Sec 2. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to dispose of all old junk and rubbish now laying around the Fire Stations, such as old fire hose, wheels, harness, and any and all materials or apparatus which can be of no further use to the City, the same to be disposed of to the best advantage of the City of San Antonio.

The following resolution was read and adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the City Attorney prepare for printing a correct copy of the Charter of the City of San Antonio as same now exists, with an index thereto.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Purchasing Agent secure bids for the printing of Two Hundred copies of said charter, as prepared by the City Attorney.

Petition of W.D.Syers for permit to construct shingle roofs was rejected on recommendation of the Building Inspector and Chief of the Fire Department.
