SUBJECT: Request for Placement of Item on Governance Committee Agenda

Issue Proposed for Consideration

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the Governance Committee:

Your support is requested to direct the Department of Development Services to change the name of a portion of East Ashley Road to "Acequia" and change the remaining portion of East Ashley Road to "Mission Rd", for purposes of public safety and general directional clarity. The associated fees for the street name change will be paid by City Council District 3 One time Funds. Thanks you for your consideration.

Brief Background

As the attached map indicates, E. Ashley runs east bound adjacent to the Stinson Airfield. When you pass the airfield, you have the opportunity to turn left at the next intersection. That road too is named E. Ashley therefore causing a confusing "E Ashley Rd. & E. Ashley Rd." intersection. It is the intent of the District 3 Council office to use One Time monies to remedy this situation by changing appropriate sections of E. Ashley to "Mission Rd." and "Acequia Rd." respectively. The name change also clears up confusion in this area because of the three Ashley roads within the same vicinity all close to the airfield that will increase in use very soon.

In prior fiscal years during the budget process, City Council authorized the appropriation of One Time Project Funds for each Council District. These funds were to be appropriated by Council Members to fund various projects within their districts. In instances where the projects have been completed for less than the appropriated amount or where the funds are no longer needed, the remaining funds may be reallocated by the Council Member, subject to approval by the full City Council. Your concurrence is therefore appreciated.
