MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS.

THE following petitions were read and referred to the Commissioner of Fire & Police: Petition of Jack Neal Nash Motors Co. to erect Drive In Station at corner of Augusta and Richmond Ave. Petition of Jack Neal Nash Motors Co. to Install Two Gasoline Tanks at corner of Augusta & Richmond Ave.

The following petitions were read and referred to the Commissioner of Parks, Sanitation etc., Petition of Knights of Pythias, Colored, for permit to use San Pedro Springs Park June 19th, 20th, 21st 1922. Petition of Knights of Pythias, Colored Lodges & Court of Calanthea for use of San Pedro Park on June 5th to 10th 1922 for Grand Lodge Celebration. Petition of Colored Citizens for use of San Pedro Park to celebrate Emancipation Proclamation.

Commissioner of Fire & Police made the following recommendations which were adopted: Petition of Flora M. Gurden for Electric Sign Corner Ave C & Pecan Sts. granted. Petition of Casa del Rio for permit to erect electric sign 100 block E. Houston Street granted. Petition of The Spalding Co. 206 Losoya St. for permit to erect electric sign granted.

The City Engineer recommended that the paving of W. Myrtle St., from Main Avenue to McCullough Avenue be awarded to Southwest Bitulithic Company; and that the paving of W. Myrtle Street, between San Pedro and Main Avenue be awarded to the Southwest Bitulithic Company. Adopted.
