Gentlemen:

Under the authority vested in me as Mayor Pro Tempore by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I hereby call you into Special Session on this the 5th day of June, 1939, at 10:00 o'Clock A. M. for the purpose of submitting for your consideration the following:


