

AN ORDINANCE 2013-08-29-0565

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$15,675.00 TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES FOR A TOBACCO COMPLIANCE GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) has grant funds available in an amount up to \$15,675.00 for enforcement of the laws prohibiting the sale to and use by minors of tobacco; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is September 1, 2013, through August 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said grant does not require either a cash or in-kind matching contribution; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The actions of City staff in submitting a grant application in the amount of \$15,675.00 to the DSHS for a Tobacco Compliance grant for the period September 1, 2013, to August 31, 2014, are hereby ratified. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 2. A new fund will be created for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. The sum of up to \$15,675.00 from the DSHS will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget attached hereto as **Exhibit I** is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.






