Petition of the Denver Heights Church of Christ, filed on October 29, 1947, by the Reverend A. Hugh Clark, Minister, requesting tax exemption on church property described as lots 5, 6, 7 & 8, New City Block 6637. Petition denied because of adverse legal opinion in regard to the eligibility of this property for tax exemption.

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On motion of Commissioner Hein, seconded by Commissioner Davis, that the Council reject the bids for lots on Stadium Drive and East Crockett Street: Motion carried by a roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Callaghan, Davis, Hein and Knight; Nays, South (absent).

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On motion of Commissioner Davis, seconded by Commissioner Knight, that Mayor Callaghan be granted a leave of absence for May 31st and June 1, 2 & 3rd: Motion carried by a roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Davis, Hein and Knight; Nays, South (absent); Mayor Callaghan not voting.

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On motion of Commissioner Davis, seconded by Commissioner Knight, that the meeting be recessed until Tuesday, June 1st, at 10:00 A.M. Motion carried by a roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Callaghan, Davis, Hein, and Knight; Nays, South (absent); meeting was recessed.
