

AN ORDINANCE      2011-12-15-1062

**APPROVING AN APPOINTMENT TO THE WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS  
ALAMO BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE REMAINDER OF A TERM  
TO EXPIRE DECEMBER 31, 2012.**

**WHEREAS**, all vacancies on the Workforce Solutions Alamo (“WSA”) Board of Directors must be filled within 90 days from the date of vacancy in order for the Board to remain in compliance with Texas Workforce Commission standards and statutory requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council, as well as Bexar County and the WSA-Area Judges must consider and take action regarding an appointment to fill a vacancy left by Ernest Serrato as recommended by the Committee of Six on November 30, 2011; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** City Council approves the appointment of Roscoe (Rocky) B. Marshall, Jr. for Place 10, (Business Commerce Category) for the remainder of a term to expire December 31, 2012.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of at least eight affirmative votes; if less than eight affirmative votes are received, then this Ordinance shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.






