

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN THE
CITY COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON
THURSDAY, JANUARY 12th, 1961, AT 8:30 A.M.

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The regular meeting of the City Council was called to order at 8:30 A.M.

Mayor Kuykendall announced that Mr. Roy S. Padilla, recently elected to fill the vacancy in the Council membership Place #7 caused by the resignation of Mr. Joe Olivares, was on hand to take the Oath of Office. The City Clerk administered the Oath.
