

AN ORDINANCE 2011-03-03-0159

AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH H.L. ZUMWALT CONSTRUCTION, INC., IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,207,693.98 TO CONSTRUCT STREET, DRAINAGE, TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN ACCESS RELATED PROJECTS FOR THE 2011-2012 TASK ORDER CONTRACT PACKAGE VII PUBLIC WORKS INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the 2011-2012 Task Order Contract Package VII will be utilized to construct streets, drainage, traffic and pedestrian access related projects; and

WHEREAS, funding for these projects may include, but is not limited to, Federally funded programs such as the Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG), Housing and Urban Development (HUD) 108 program, Tax Notes/Bond related programs and other General Funded Programs such as Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program (NAMP), 2011 Sidewalk / Street Maintenance Infrastructure Management Program (IMP) and other identified funding sources; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **H.L. Zumwalt Construction, Inc.** in the amount not to exceed \$5,207,693.98; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works will utilize the construction services of **H.L. Zumwalt Construction, Inc.**, on an as-needed basis in order to expedite project delivery and completion; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **H.L. Zumwalt Construction, Inc.** in the amount not to exceed \$5,207,693.98 for the 2011-2012 Task Order Contract Package VII Public Works Infrastructure maintenance and construction Projects is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A Task Order Construction Contract is hereby awarded to **H.L. Zumwalt Construction, Inc.**

SECTION 3. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding for this Ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts

budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

- b) Payment not to exceed \$5,207,693.98 is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to **H.L. Zumwalt Construction, Inc.** for construction services.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.




