

AN ORDINANCE 2011-09-01-0720

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF FOUR (4) AGREEMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF \$49,135.00 FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL INTERSECTIONS LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICTS 4, 6, 8 AND 9.

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WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is funding improvement projects on SH 16, Loop 1604, US 281 and Fredericksburg Road; and

WHEREAS, these projects provide for the installation of traffic signal communications equipment at the following four locations:

- Hwy 16 and S. Zarzamora – the addition of left turn lanes and the conversion of an existing flashing beacon to a traffic signal at that intersection for an amount not to exceed \$13,950.00,
- Loop 1604 and SH 151 - the construction of an underpass to include a new traffic signal on the west side of the underpass where the Loop 1604 frontage road meets US 151/Alamo Ranch Pkwy, for an amount not to exceed \$13,635.00,
- US 281 and Sonterra Boulevard - the conversion of an existing flashing beacon to a traffic signal at that intersection, for an amount not to exceed \$13,950.00,
- Fredericksburg Road and Medical Drive - a grade separation to include a new traffic signal on Fredericksburg Road at this location, for an amount not to exceed \$7,600.00; and

WHEREAS, to maintain compatibility with the City’s existing traffic signal system, the Public Works Department will purchase and install traffic signal communications equipment for the 4 intersections along these projects and TxDOT will reimburse the City for these costs; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the City to enter into four (4) agreements with TxDOT to purchase and install the traffic signal equipment for a total amount not to exceed \$49,135.00; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute four (4) Agreements with the Texas Department of Transportation in an amount not to exceed \$49,135.00 for the purchase and installation the traffic signal communication equipment for traffic signal intersections located in Council Districts 4, 6, 8 and 9.

SECTION 2. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding in the amount of \$49,135.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 29615000 as part of the Fiscal Year 2011 Budget per the table below.


- d) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.




