

AN ORDINANCE 2008-01-10-0005

**AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO REIMBURSE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$51,750.00 FOR THE COST OF FURNISHING AND INSTALLING TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT ALONG THE IH-35 FRONTAGE ROAD AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF FM 78 (OLD SEGUIN ROAD), BINZ-ENGLEMAN ROAD, AND RITTIMAN ROAD.**

**WHEREAS**, this Project consists of furnishing and installing of traffic signal equipment along the IH 35 Frontage Road at the intersections of FM 78 (Old Seguin) Road, Binz-Engleman Road, and Rittiman Road; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes the City Manager or her designee to execute an agreement for the furnishing and installing of traffic signal equipment by a municipality with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) in connection with the furnishing and installing of traffic signal equipment along the IH 35 Frontage Road at the intersections of FM 78 (Old Seguin) Road, Binz-Engleman Road, and Rittiman Road; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure compatibility with the City's existing traffic signal system, the Public Works Traffic Operations staff will be responsible for the acquisition and installation of traffic signal equipment for these locations and TxDOT will reimburse the City in an amount not to exceed \$51,750.00; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of Council policy to collaborate with other governmental agencies in the development and construction of City infrastructure and to upgrade traffic signals, as funds are made available, **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement For The Furnishing and Installing of traffic signal equipment by a municipality with the Texas Department of Transportation to furnish and install traffic signal equipment along the IH 35 Frontage Road at the intersections of FM 78 (Old Seguin) Road, Binz-Engleman Road, and Rittiman Road.

**SECTION 2.** The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) The \$51,750.00 in fees generated by this ordinance will be deposited into Fund 29615000 Internal Order 223000000192 General Ledger 4501110 when received from TXDOT.
- b) An appropriation of these funds is authorized as distributed below and the FY08 budget is amended to reflect same.


*MCS* **SECTION <sup>4</sup> 4.** This ordinance shall be effective on the tenth day following passage.


