

AN ORDINANCE 2010-08-12-0693

APPROVING “CAFÉ COLLEGE” AS THE NAME OF THE CITY'S  
COLLEGE ACCESS CENTER AS RECOMMENDED BY THE  
CONVENED NAMING COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE  
CITY'S CODE REGULATING THE NAMING OF CITY FACILITIES.

**WHEREAS**, on June 24, 2010 City Council approved an adjustment to the 45 day waiting period set forth in the City Code addressing naming of City facilities (Chapter 6, Buildings, Naming of City Facilities and Streets) to permit a 14 day waiting period before the naming committee could hold a public hearing to consider the suggested name of Café College for the College Access Center located at 131 El Paso Street; and

**WHEREAS**, this adjustment allowed that a recommended name be presented to the City Council for approval in August; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the proposed name was disseminated through mailings and a public hearing on the proposed name change was held on August 3, 2010 at the Frank Garrett Community Center on 1226 NW 18<sup>TH</sup> Street; and

**WHEREAS**, no persons attended the hearing to oppose the proposed name; and

**WHEREAS**, the committee members voted in favor of the proposed name and recommended that the name be forwarded to City Council with its rationale for supporting it; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee's rationale for approving the name was that it targets youth and is reflective of the purpose of the center which is to provide students with a “Café” of options and opportunities related to access to college; and

**WHEREAS**, due to need for expedience in effecting the naming, City Council believes that the purpose for, and input required by, the City Code procedures for naming facilities has been satisfied; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** City Council approves “Café College” as the name of the City's College Access Center as recommended by the convened Naming Committee in accordance with the City's Code regulating the naming of City facilities.

**SECTION 2.** City Council finds that the purpose for, and input required by, the City Code procedures for naming facilities has been satisfied. Therefore, the City-owned building at 131 El Paso in Downtown San Antonio is hereby named Café College.

**SECTION 3.** There is no fiscal impact realized through the passage of this Ordinance.
