THURSDAY, JUNE 6TH, A.D.1918, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation: Diocesan School of Western Texas, for exemption from Taxation. J.T.Blanks, for correction of assessment.

Commissioner Heuermann introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Coy, Lambert, Heuermann and Wright.

No. 4 *MC-339* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$110.00 out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Mrs. Dora Stumberg for rent of 224 W.Nueva Street for month of June 1918.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of One Hundred ten and no/100 Dollars (\$110.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is, hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Mrs Dora Stumberg for rent of 224 W.Nueva Street for the month of June, 1918.

Commissioner Coy introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

No. 5 *-340* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$6.80 to pay Mrs Phoebe Trace Storms.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Six and 80/100 (\$6.80) Dollars (the school portion being \$1.80) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund to pay Mrs. Phoebe Trace Storms for taxes collected from her on account of erroneous assessment.

No. 6 *-341* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating funds for expenses of election.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$1450 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Special Emergencies and Contingency Fund to pay expenses of Special Election held June 4, 1918.

The request of Depot Quartermaster U.S.A. for the installation of 5 arc lamps along the Seguin Road east of New Braunfels Avenue, for the accomodation of traffic to and from Government establishments, was granted, location to be determined by Depot Quartermaster and the City Electrician.

Commissioner Coy presented a bond covering employes in the Department of Taxation which was read and approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners.

Petition of C.F.Russi for permit to maintain shooting gallery for private use only at 1014 Lakeview Ave, was granted by the Commissioners.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

No. 7 MC-342 AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$233.99 out of 1918 General Fund to pay labor and material used in extending 6" water main at Municipal Farm.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Two Hundred and thirty three and 99/100 Dollars, (\$233.99) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is, hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay H.M.Truehart & Co. for labor and material furnished in making extension of 6" watermain to Municipal Farm, per itemized bill on file in office of City Auditor.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

No. 8 - 343 AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$187.42 out of 1918 General Fund to pay Peden Iron and Steel Co. for dynamite and blasting powder furnished City Rock Quarry.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of One Hundred and eighty seven and 42/100 Dollars (\$187.42) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is, hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Peden Iron and Steel Co. for 10 cases of dynamite and 25 kegs blasting powder for use at City Rock Quarry. See bill on file in office of City Auditor.

Petition of Sam Resica for permit to install gasoline equipment at 601 S.Laredo St. was granted.
