Petition of Ella Felder, for correction of assessment, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Citizens, for sanitary sewers on Iowa Street.

County Judge of Bexar County, relating to certain street improvements in eastern part of the City.

Application of Dixie Oil and Refining Company to erect storage tank at Medina and El Paso Streets, was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

No. 210 **MB-287** AN ORDINANCE

Directing the payment of salaries and wages for services rendered by officers and employes of the City for the month of December, 1916, and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the payment of officers and employes for the several accounts and departments as specified in the attached schedule as salaries or wages for services rendered to the City during the month of December, 1916, as per pay rolls;

of which respective amounts City warrants shall at once ^{be} issued and delivered to said respective payees; provided that all persons performing services for the City for uncertain periods, may be paid on pay rolls certified to be correct by the Commissioner of the Department or the Chief of the division in which they are engaged, and each person so paid shall thereupon receipt said pay roll, all as provided by City Charter.

Wooten, for bacteriological supplies used from April 1, 1915 to August 1, 1916 per itemized statement on file in City Auditors office.

LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS AND TAXES on account of the cost of the improvement of West Travis Street, from Main Avenue to North Flores Street, and to provide for the issuance of assessment certificates and for other purposes.

-294 AN ORDINANCE

Granting permit to Joe Zimmerman to construct a sanitary sewer in South Mesquite Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted Joe Zimmerman to construct an 8" sanitary sewer, beginning at a manhole on South Mesquite Street and Delaware Street and extending seventy five (75) feet south to a point opposite lot two, City Block 666, according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached, the cost of said sewer being estimated about Ninety five dollars, to be paid by the said Joe Zimmerman. The final actual cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten (10) days after the completion of the sewer.

Section 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system. No charges for connection will be made.

MB-295 AN ORDINANCE

Granting permit to Peter O'Brien, to construct sanitary sewer in South Mesquite Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted Peter O'Brien to construct an eight (8") inch sanitary sewer, beginning 75 feet south of manhole on South Mesquite and Delaware Streets and extending one hundred feet (100') south to a point opposite lot four (4) city block 666, according to plat, line and grade made by the City Engineer hereto attached, the cost of said sewer being estimated about Sixty (60) Dollars, to be paid by the said Peter O'Brien. The final actual cost to be filed with the City Engineer within ten (10) days after the completion of the sewer.

Section 2. Said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and part of its public sewer system. No charges for connection will be made.

Commissioner Kearny recommended that the name Fredericksburg Road be changed to "Fredericksburg Boulevard", in accordance with petition of citizens. Adopted.

Bids for building sidewalk on the South side of W. Travis Street from Main Avenue to North Flores Street were opened and read.

- 303 AN ORDINANCE

Ordering the laying of sidewalks, etc, on various streets, under the penalties for failure to comply with said order.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS The City Commissioners in the exercise of the Police Power, finds and hereby declares a public necessity for the laying of sidewalks etc, as hereinafter ordered; and

WHEREAS by an ordinance heretofore on the 10th day of August, A.D.1914, passed and approved this City Commissioners provided for such cases; said ordinance being entitled "An ordinance prescribing specifications for sidewalks and curbing for Public Streets and Places, and providing measures to compel the laying, construction and repair of the same by owners of abutting property; requiring the cost thereof to be paid by the owners of such property and declaring such cost a personal liability of such owners, and a first and prior lien and charge against such property; and prescribing the manner of ordering and compelling the construction of such work, and the punishment for failure to comply with such orders", and proceeding hereupon in accordance with said previous ordinance, which is made a part hereof;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED:

Section One. That the construction of cement sidewalks be and the same is hereby ordered along or in front of the entire extent of each parcel of the property and premises hereinafter described, and that owners of such premises proceed immediately to construct said improvements, or to cause same to be constructed at their cost and expense, on the streets and public places hereinafter named; the respective premises herein referred to, the owner or owners ~~XXXXXX~~ thereof to whom this order is addressed and each such respective street or public place being as follows, to-wit:

That said improvements shall be constructed promptly in accordance with the specifications and other provisions contained in said ordinance of August 10, 1914, and that said work shall be commenced within thirty days after the service of notice on this order, and that said notices shall be given and all other things shall be done as therein provided; and that for failure to comply with or violation of this order, any person, association of persons, or corporation found guilty of such offense shall be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, all under as in said ordinance of August 10, 1914, provided.
