RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 19th. day of December, A. D. 1935, an Ordinance was duly passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio regulating and licensing taxicabs, creating the office of Inspector of Taxicabs, and providing generally for the supervision of said business by the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, under SECTION 9 of said Ordinance in order to defray a part of the expense necessary to provide surveillance, supervision and inspection of taxicabs by the City of San Antonio there is levied a fee of \$20.00 per annum for each taxicab operated in the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, considering the fact that the owners of taxicabs now operating under said Ordinance have recently been compelled to furnish public liability insurance issued by an approved insurance company authorized to do business in Texas, or to furnish a surety bond executed by an approved corporation authorized to conduct bonding business in Texas, causing said owners to pay out large sums of money for premiums and fees, same being an item or expense not anticipated prior to the passage of said Ordinance, it is the desire and request of said taxicabs owners that the aforesaid surveillance, supervision and inspection fee of \$20.00 per annum for the fiscal year commencing June 1st. A. D. 1936 and ending May 31st, 1937. and for that year only, be reduced to \$10.00 per annum for each taxicab so operated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That we, the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, on account of the foregoing facts, do hereby reduce the surveillance, supervision and inspection fee of \$20.00 per annum for each taxicab operated in the City of San Antonio to \$10.00 per annum for each taxicab so operated for and during the fiscal year ending May 31, 1937, and for said year only.
