The mayor and commissioners elect gathered in the Council Chamber at 10 A.M. June 1 A.D 1951, for the purpose of taking their several oaths of office and assuming their duties.

Mayor White in a very short introductory talk presented Rev. Roy Rihn and called upon him for the invocation.

After the invocation Mayor White introduced Mr. Wilbur Matthews and asked him to take charge of the meeting.

Mr. Matthews made a talk on the subject of city growth and asked for combined efforts of all citizens to aid the new administration in its work. He then introduced Hon. W. O. Murray Chief Justice of Court of Civil Appeals, Fourth Supreme Judicial District.

Judge Murray then called in turn Mayor A. C. White, re-elected to be mayor. T. N. Tucker, elected Tax Commissioner; Alvin E. Schmidt, Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks & Public Property; Sam Bell Steves elected Commissioner of Street & Public Improvements; and G. M. Roper elected Fire and Police Commissioner, and administered the oath prescribed by the law of the State of Texas.

Mayor White then called upon Rev. S. Chessy Lovern, Pastor of Laurel Heights Methodist Church who led in prayer; and upon Hon. Charles W. Anderson, County Judge of Bexar County who congratulated the newly formed council.

Mayor White then announced that the ceremony was at an end but all who wished to would be welcome if they remained for a brief Council meeting.

Transferring the Departments of Weights and Measures, Electrical Inspector, Plumbing Inspector and Building Inspector from the jurisdiction of the Police & Fire Commissioner to the jurisdiction of the Commissioner of Sanitation Parks & Public Property;

Abolishing the Office of License & Dues Collector and transferring the duties now in that office to the office of Deputy Tax Collector;

Approving Bond of the Tax Commissioner.


The bond of T. N. Tucker as Tax Commissioner for \$100,00.00 was approved.
