ML-43 AN ORDINANCE

Accepting bid of R. L. Fish, for a Concession in Koehler Park for the purpose of constructing and operating therein a Shetland Pony Track.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the Bid of R. L. Fish, hereto attached and made a part hereof, for a Concession known as a Shetland Pony Track Concession in Koehler Park, authorizing the construction and operation of a Shetland Pony Track for the purpose of permitting such ponies to be ridden over said track by children, and for the purpose of permitting pony carts and goat carts to be driven and drawn over and along said track, for the entertainment and amusement of said children, which bid was made in response to an advertisement for bids for such Concession in Koehler Park, be and the same is hereby accepted.

2. And the Mayor is authorized to execute the form of contract thereon as in the advertisement thereof specified, referred to and approved by the council for the City.

3. All other bids are hereby rejected.
