

AN ORDINANCE **2009-11-19-0913**

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$87,242.08, TO THE \$2,910,980.29 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS FOR CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES FOR THE SAN ANTONIO RIVER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT – EAGLELAND RIVERWALK LINK – PEDESTRIAN PHASE PROJECT.

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WHEREAS, the San Antonio River Improvements Project – Eagleland Riverwalk Link - Pedestrian Phase Project is one segment of the San Antonio River Improvement Project which extends the San Antonio Riverwalk from Guenther to south of Alamo Street on a pier-supported walkway within the river channel; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 81976 approved on March 30, 1995 authorized a professional services agreement in the amount of \$485,000.00 for professional engineering services in connection with Mission Trails Enhancement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project connects to a pedestrian overlook of the river that was previously constructed with the Eagleland Hike and Bike Phase Project; and

WHEREAS, prior amendments have increased the amount of this contract to \$2,910,980.29 and this amendment of \$87,242.08 will increase the contract amount to \$2,998,222.37; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved Advanced Transportation District and Metropolitan Planning Organization funded projects, as well as provide Local Agency Management of selected TxDOT projects; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The professional engineering services contract between the City of San Antonio and **Civil Engineering Consultants** is amended in the amount of \$87,242.08 for construction phase services.

SECTION 2. The following financial adjustments are hereby authorized to effect this Ordinance:

- a) Section 1: The budget in SAP Fund 43099000, SAP Project Definition 23-00504, SARIP - Eagleland River Walk/Pedestrian, and the budget shall be revised by increasing/decreasing SAP WBS Element as follows:

- b) The amount of \$87,242.08 from SAP Fund 43099000, SAP Project Definition 23-00504, SARIP - Eagleland River Walk/Pedestrian, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Civil engineering Consultants** for construction phase services.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.


