Bonds

Providing for the sale of Improvement District 14 to the Sinking Fund of Improvement District No. 4

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, S

Section 1. That a certain series of bonds dated August 1, 1919 issued on the credit of Improvement District No. 14 of this City in the sum of \$17,500.00, in denomination of \$500.00 each and bearing numbers from 1 to 35, be and is hereby ordered sold and transferred to the Sinking Fund of Improvement District No. 4 of this City.

Section 2. That the sum of \$17,500.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Sinking Fund of Improvement District No. 4 to be invested in said bonds of Improvement District Number 14.

Section 3. That the sum realized from the sale and transfer of said bonds into Improvement District No. 4 Sinking Fund, be and is hereby ordered deposited in Improvement District No. 14 Fund, to be used for the purpose of accomplishing the improvements in Improvement District No. 14, contemplated under said issue of bonds.

Commissioner Wright recommended that the petition of the Continental Hotel for permit to erect an electric sign at 722 W. Commerce Street be granted. Adopted.
