

Commissioner Hein explained the proposal regarding "Better Baseball Inc", and the City Attorney discussed form of contract with Commissioner Hein and Manor Puckett. They arranged to get together and work up a contract.

Commissioner Davis made a suggestion that an Ordinance be passed setting a definite rate for sewer connections outside the City limits to cover all adjacent suburbs. Commissioner Knight asked that the matter be delayed until he can make a statement regarding the claims of Alamo Heights, after a conference which he has arranged with officials of that municipality. Discussion was entered into generally. The Mayor and all Commissioners taking part and it was agreed to wait until Commissioner Knight reports the results of the conference.
