

A RESOLUTION
NO. 92-03-02
ENDORISING THE CONCEPT OF A MISSION PARKWAY
AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN ROGER PEREZ
AND COUNCILWOMAN LINDA BILLA BURKE.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the Missions of San Antonio (San Jose, Espada, San Juan, Concepcion and the Alamo) are the most complete collection of Spanish Colonial Structures on the North American Continent, and as such, constitute a national treasure; and

WHEREAS, preservation of the Missions of San Antonio serves the interests the citizens of San Antonio and Bexar County, by providing perpetual living monuments to the significant cultural contributions of those who established the Missions; and

WHEREAS, the people of the United States of America, through their representatives duly elected to Congress, did in 1978 make known their support for the Missions of San Antonio by creating the San Antonio Missions National Historic Park; and

WHEREAS, the people of the United States of America, Mexico, and other counties continue to demonstrate their support for the Missions of San Antonio by visiting them in numbers in excess of 500,000 per year; and

WHEREAS, the development of a Missions Parkway would: (1) further enhance the cultural appreciation of the Missions as the collection of communities which shared the common bond of the San Antonio River; (2) improve the ability of Missions visitors to find and travel to and between the Missions, thereby broadening and heightening awareness of the cultural significance of the Missions to contemporary society; and (3) promote appropriate economic development and associated employment opportunities in the southern sector of the city, some of the residents of which are direct descendants of the original Missions inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, a Mission Parkway, in any one of the many possible alternate alignments and configurations, would be situated in no less than three City Council Districts, three County Commissioners Precincts, and three Congressional Districts; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

The City of San Antonio endorses the development of a Missions Parkway to promote the development and adoption of a Missions Parkway plan consistent with the cultural, historical, and neighborhood resources of the area.
