

AN ORDINANCE

2008-09-11-0794

AUTHORIZING A ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE AGREEMENT WITH ALCOHOL AND DRUG TESTS, INC. TO PROVIDE BOTH RANDOM AND REASONABLE SUSPICION DRUG TESTING SERVICES FOR THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT AT AN AMOUNT UP TO \$35,000.00.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the current collective bargaining agreement with the San Antonio Police Officers Association, the San Antonio Police Department is authorized to conduct random and reasonable suspicion drug testing of its sworn personnel; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 101466, the City entered into a one-year contract with Alcohol and Drug Tests, Inc. to provide said drug testing to the SAPD; and

WHEREAS, said contract provided for three one-year extensions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2006-09-21-1090, the City entered into a one-year extension of said contract for the period October 1, 2006, to September 30, 2007; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2007-08-09-0863, the City entered into a second one-year extension of said contract for the period October 1, 2007, to September 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a third extension of said contract, for the period October 1, 2008, to September 30, 2009, for an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute a one-year extension of the contract with Alcohol and Drug Tests, Inc. entered into pursuant to Ordinance No. 101466 to provide random and reasonable suspicion drug testing services to the San Antonio Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00. The terms and conditions contained in the attached contract extension are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Funding for the operating portion of this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000 (General Fund), Cost Center 1701010006, General Ledger 5201040, contingent upon approval of the FY2009 budget. Payment not to exceed \$35,000.00 is authorized and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.

CONTRACT EXTENSION

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of San Antonio Ordinance No. 01466, the City of San Antonio and Alcohol and Drug Tests, Inc. entered into an agreement to provide random and reasonable suspicion drug testing for the San Antonio Police Department; and

WHEREAS, said agreement provided for an initial term ending September 30, 2006, and provided for three one-year extensions upon agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the parties agreed to extend said agreement for one year, for the period commencing October 1, 2006, and ending September 30, 2007, and executed an contract extension to that effect; and

WHEREAS, later, the parties agreed to extend said agreement for another year, for the period commencing October 1, 2007, and ending September 30, 2008, and executed an contract extension to that effect; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to extend said agreement for a third one-year period, commencing October 1, 2008, and ending September 30, 2009; **NOW THEREFORE:**

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The agreement between the City of San Antonio and Alcohol and Drug Tests, Inc., entered into pursuant to City of San Antonio Ordinance No. 101466, to provide random and reasonable suspicion drug testing for the San Antonio Police Department is hereby extended for one year, for the period October 1, 2008, to September 30, 2009.
