

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN  
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON  
TUESDAY, MAY 28, 1991.

The meeting was called to order by the Presiding Officer, Mayor Lila Cockrell, with the following members present: BERRIOZABAL, DUTMER, THOMPSON, WOLFF, LABATT, COCKRELL. Absent: WEBB, WING, MARTINEZ, VERA, HASSLOCHER.

91-23 The City Council members proceeded with the official canvass of the returns of the May 25, 1991 Runoff Election. The City Clerk announced that no discrepancies were found or differences from the unofficial Saturday canvass.

City Clerk Norma S. Rodriguez then read the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE 73,702

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF  
MUNICIPAL RUNOFF ELECTION HELD ON THE 25TH  
DAY OF MAY, 1991.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council convened on this 28th day of May, 1991, to canvass the returns of the runoff municipal election held on the 25th day of May, 1991, to determine the members of the Council, Place No. 1, Place No. 10 and Place No. 11 of the City of San Antonio for the ensuing term of office of two years.

SECTION 1. The City Council has met to canvass the returns and to declare the results of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all matters of fact appertaining, we, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, do hereby find and declare the results of the said election to be tabulated as follows:

FOR MEMBER OF COUNCIL, PLACE NO. 1

FOR MEMBER OF COUNCIL, PLACE NO. 10

"FOR" Betty Bueche 7,355 votes

"FOR" Lyle Larson 12,652 votes

FOR MEMBER OF COUNCIL, PLACE NO. 11 (MAYOR)

"FOR" Nelson Wolff 63,262 votes

"FOR" Maria A. Berriozabal 56,895 votes

SECTION 3. The names of the candidates were submitted and the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by the City Charter, the laws of said runoff election there were cast respectively for each of said candidates the number of votes shown above.

SECTION 4. The City Council having canvassed said returns and having found the same in all things correct, the canvass was thereupon adopted by a majority vote of the members of the Council of the City of San Antonio; and it is declared that as the result of said runoff election, the elected officers of the City of San Antonio, for Council Place No. 1, Council Place No. 10 and Council Place No. 11 (Mayor), for the two years commencing on the 1st day of June, 1991, is as follows:

Member of Council, Place No. 11 (Mayor):

NELSON WOLFF

Mrs. Dutmer made a motion to approve the proposed Ordinance. Mr. Thompson seconded the motion.

After consideration, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Ordinance, prevailed by the following vote: AYES: Berriozabal, Dutmer, Thompson, Wolff, Labatt, Cockrell; NAYS: None; ABSENT: Webb, Wing, Martinez, Vera, Hasslocher.
