SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,  
HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, AT ELEVEN O'CLOCK,  
A. M., ON MONDAY, THE NINTH DAY OF DECEMBER, A. D. 1946.

The Clerk read the call, as follows:

December 9th, 1946.

To the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio:-

Gentlemen:-

Under the authority vested in me as Mayor by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I call you hereby in a Special Meeting required for the good of the City of San Antonio to convene at 11:00 o'clock, A.M., on the 9 day of December, A. D. 1946, to consider and act upon:

"AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$58,781.25 OUT OF VARIOUS SINKING FUNDS, TO PAY MAY 1ST, 1947 INTEREST COUPON MATURITIES", and

"AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,750,000 INTERREGIONAL HIGHWAY BONDS, SERIES A-45; \$1,500,000 AIRPORT ADMINISTRATION BUILDING BONDS, SERIES B-45; \$2,000,000 STREET AND BRIDGE BONDS, SERIES C-45; \$300,000 GARBAGE DISPOSAL BONDS, SERIES E-45, AND \$150,000 FIRE STATION BONDS, SERIES U-45, OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, CONFIRMING THE SALE THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES TO PAY PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS', TO CORRECT TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR".

Comm. Callaghan announced that he was "going to vote 'nay'" on the ordinances because the old City bonds had been signed by the Tax Commissioner and registered with the City Treasurer, and these bonds had not.

Mayor Mauermann stated these bonds had been handled according to the law, said laws having been passed before he became Mayor.

City Attorney Cobbs, at the request of the Mayor, stated that under the State law, the bonds had only to be signed by the Mayor and City Clerk.

Comm. Anderson added that this law went into effect "about eight years ago".

## AN ORDINANCE (4347)

AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,750,000 INTERREGIONAL HIGHWAY BONDS, SERIES A-45; \$1,500,000 AIRPORT ADMINISTRATION BUILDING BONDS, SERIES B-45; \$2,000,000 STREET AND BRIDGE BONDS, SERIES C-45; \$300,000 GARBAGE DISPOSAL BONDS, SERIES E-45; AND \$150,000 FIRE STATION BONDS, SERIES U-45, OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, CONFIRMING THE SALE THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES TO PAY PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS", TO CORRECT TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR.

Before the vote on the above ordinance, it was explained by City Attorney Cobbs.

Comm. Callaghan objected to the absence of money for sewer purposes or storm sewers in the bond issue.

Mayor Mauermann stated: "We would be glad to have you introduce an ordinance calling for more bonds" for that purpose.

Comm. Callaghan replied that he did not know why it was not included in the first place.

Comm. Hein pointed out the \$300,000 for a garbage incinerator would not be enough, due to increased costs, stating \$500,000 was needed.

Comm. Anderson, stating he wanted to keep the record straight, added that there had been a sewer bond issue proposed, which was defeated at the polls.

The vote by roll call, as recorded above, followed.


