The Clerk read the call of the meeting.

City Manager Matthews stated he had gone over some of the problems with Mr. Conner, Special Attorney for City, Mr. Bolen and Mr. Cadena, regarding Mr. Alexander's report on the Transit Company's fare increase request, and thought several things in this report may or may not be acceptable. He said he had seven firms in mind which might be hired as consultants to check the accuracy of the reports, thought that in a matter of a week's time the figures could be proved. Mr. Matthews stated he would like to have the Administrative Staff (Mr. Bolen, Mr. Cadena and Mr. Conner) discuss the reports with the Transit Company. After some discussion by the Council members, Mr. Daniels moved that the Administrative Staff meet and discuss with the Transit Company in order to ascertain what points, if any, are in issue in Mr. Alexander's Report; seconded by Mr. Passur, the motion carried by the following vote: AYES, Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Crumrine, Winton, Olivares, Daniels, San Martin; NAYS, None; ABSENT, Kuykendall.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
