Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:
 Army Post Garage, for permit to install gasoline tank.
 R.G.Pump, for permit to install gasoline tank and pump at 112 Travis Street.
 Magnolia Petroleum Co. for permit to construct Drive-in Gasoline filling station, in City Block 782, S.Alamo Street.

Petition of E.H.Labadie Auto Company for readjustment of certain taxes, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Bids for furnishing rings and manhole covers and one gasoline pump to City, were referred to City Purchasing Agent.

No. 430 **MC-891** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$592.74 to pay Colglazier Cons. Co.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Five Hundred and Ninety Two and 74/100 (\$592.74) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Colglazier Cons. Co. for maintenance of San Pedro Park Roadways from March 31, 1919 to March 31, 1920, as per contract, and in accordance with approved estimate on file in the office of the City Auditor.

No. 431 **-892** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$81.03 to pay Colglazier Cons. Co.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$81.03 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Colglazier Construction Company the City's part for tarviating Agarita Avenue, between Belknap Place and Howard Street.

No. 432 **MC-894** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$400.00 to pay for printing and mailing postal cards, Charter Amendment.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$400.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay for printing and mailing 16500 postal cards with the Charter Amendment to be voted on at the special election to be held June 9, 1919.

No. 433 **-895** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$5.60 to pay R.A. Strosser.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Five and 60/100 (\$5.60) Dollars (the Schools Portion being \$1.40) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay R.A. Strosser, taxes collected in error on an automobile not owned by him.

No. 434 **-896** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$24,000.00 to pay regular merchants bills for month of April, 1919.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Twenty Four Thousand dollars, (\$24,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is, hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Merchants Bills for the month of April 1919 for following departments.
