AN ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING \$9,000.00 TO PAY GEORGE HAGELSTEIN FOR LAND NECESSARY FOR NEW RIVER CHANNEL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the sum of \$9,000.00, or as much thereof as is necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Flood Prevention and Storm Sewer Fund of 1928, to pay George Hagelstein for Tract "A", being a parcel of land out of Lot No. A-5, New City Block 834, necessary for the new river channel; said money shall be taken out of Appropriation 296, dated the 25th of november, 1929, wherein \$125,000.00 was allocated for this purpose.
2. Upon the delivery of the deed, approved by the City Attorney, the Auditor is directed to deliver City Warrants in the above amount; the deed is ordered filed by the City Clerk; and the City Engineer and City Tax Assessor are hereby directed to change their records accordingly.

APPROPRIATING \$1,000.00 TO PAY GEORGE HAGELSTEIN FOR LAND NECESSARY FOR THE EXTENSION OF OF EIGHTH STREET.
