THURSDAY, OCTOBER 21ST, A.D.1920, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Heuermann, Wright. Absent, Coy.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

## ----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition of C. Bloch for refund of taxes, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

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The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:

To have Kearney Street paved.

D.Sullivan & Co. for the opening of certain streets in Government Hill Addition.

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Commissioner Heuermann submitted a contract between the City and the Uvalde Company for the paving of Peck Avenue from Mittman Street to New Braunfels Avenue, which was on motion, duly seconded and carried, ordered approved.

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Commissioner Heuermann introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted:

## RESOLUTION

Accepting the paving on Peck Avenue, from Gevers to Mittman Street, by the Uvalde Company, Contractor.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the paving constructed by the Uvalde Company on Peck Avenue from Gevers Street to Mittman Street, with no omissions, the date of acceptance being hereby fixed on the 21st day of October, 1920, in accordance with report of the City Engineer, filed with the Board of Commissioners on October 21, 1920.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Seven Hundred and Sixty Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the Park Improvement Fund, for the purpose of paying the same amount into the Fire and Police Department Building Fund, to cover the value of the material removed from old Fire Department Station No. 4

AN ORDINANCE

Granting permit to T.H.C. Hyde to construct a sanitary sewer on alley between Aransas & Florida-Olive East.

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Commissioner Lambert, reporting on the petition of Women of West End District urging improvement of West End Lake ~~was read and referred to the committee on Sanitation~~ recommended that the petition be granted as to the Park features. Adopted.

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Commissioner Lambert recommended that petition of M.E. Hansen for permit to build stairway on Riverside at 102 E. Commerce Street be granted, but only over private property. Adopted.

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Bids for furnishing suction hose for Fire Department, and two solid rubber tires for Street Maintenance Department were opened and referred to City Purchasing Agent.

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The Hearings to property owners interested in the improvement of Dwyer Avenue, Adams Street, Grove Avenue and French Place, continued from Oct. 18, 1920, were again opened and concluded.


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The City Attorney was instructed to take the necessary steps to require the Finlay Method Company to repair the roadways in Brackenridge Park under the maintenance clause of its contract.


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On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
