

AN ORDINANCE 2011-03-03-0158

AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO FUQUAY, INC., IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$995,193.49 TO REHABILITATE APPROXIMATELY 1,800 FEET OF EXISTING STORM SEWER PIPE LOCATED ON MARTIN LUTHER KING (MLK) DRIVE FROM ARANSAS AVENUE TO SPRIGGS DALE, AN AUTHORIZED 2003 STORM WATER REVENUE BOND LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2.

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WHEREAS, the storm sewer pipe on Martin Luther King Drive between Aransas Avenue and Spriggsdale suffered several failures during the past three years which resulted in the roadway collapsing, causing safety issues for motorists and requiring emergency repairs; and

WHEREAS, Storm Water Operations staff temporarily repaired the failed sections of pipe by excavating the street and replacing short sections of the failed corrugated metal pipe (CMP) with new CMP and it was determined that the most effective option for a long term solution of the section of deteriorated CMP was to use the Spray Wall rehabilitation system and Pipeline Rehabilitation method; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **Fuquay, Inc.** in the amount not to exceed \$995,193.49 to rehabilitate approximately 1,800 feet of existing storm sewer pipe located on Martin Luther King Drive from Aransas Avenue to Spriggsdale; and

WHEREAS, this is a one-time capital expenditure in the amount of \$995,193.49 within budget and included in the FY 2011-2016 Capital Improvement Program Budget; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid submitted by **Fuquay, Inc.** in the amount not to exceed \$995,193.49 is hereby accepted in connection with Martin Luther King Drainage Improvement Project. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A construction contract is hereby awarded to **Fuquay, Inc.**

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount not to exceed \$995,193.49 in SAP Fund 48099000, Municipal Drainage Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01230, MLK Drainage Improvements, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Fuquay, Inc.** for construction services.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund

Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.






