

## MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JUNE 4th, A.D. 1923, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Lambert, Wright, Bushick, Steffler.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

## --- MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of P.P. Eiserloh, for payment of salary claimed due, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Petition of Arnold and Mima Klein, for correction of Assessment, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

## --- RESOLUTION---

Authorizing the City Clerk to advertize for bids for the construction of sidewalks in Brackenridge Park.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City Clerk be hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of sidewalks in Brackenridge Park, said walk to extend along the west bank of the San Antonio River, from Lambert Beach to the Koehler Park Pavilion. Plans and specifications are on file in Engineer's office. Bids will be received until 4 P.M. June 14th, and must be accompanied by a certified check to the amount of 10% of bid. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

## --- AN ORDINANCE---

Appropriating money to pay for Band Concert.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) be hereby appropriated to defray the expenses of the band concerts held in Brackenridge Park. To be charged to the Zoo Fund. Which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Tobin, Bushick, Lambert, Steffler, Wright.

## --- AN ORDINANCE---

Appropriating the sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) out of the 1922 General Fund, payable to the City National Bank of San Antonio, Texas, to retire 14 Notes Nos. 18 to 31 inc., of a Series of Notes Nos. 1 to 46 inc., in the principal sum of \$50,000.00 each, payable to the City National Bank. Also appropriating \$14,000.00 out of 1922 General Fund Contingencies Dept, to pay intrest on said 14 Notes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS of the City of San Antonio, that,  
SECTION ONE: That the sum of \$700,000.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund, payable to City National Bank of San Antonio, Texas, to retire Notes Nos. 18 to 31 inc, of a series of Notes Nos. 1 to 46 inc., in the principal sum of \$50,000.00 each, payable to the City National Bank, dated Jan. 15th. 1923, bearing intrest at the rate of 5% per annum, maturing on or before June 1st 1923, said notes having been issued in pursuance of an ordinance passed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 15th day of Jan. 1923, which ordinance is recorded in Vol. E Page 336 et seq. of the Minutes of the Commissioners on file in the City Clerks Office.

SECTION TWO: That the sum of \$14,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is hereby appropriated out of 1922 General Fund (Contingencies Dept.) payable to said City National Bank, to pay intrest on said Notes Nos. 18 to 31 inc. said intrest being at the rate of 5% per annum from Feb. 10th 1923 to date of retirement.

SECTION THREE: The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to prepare proper warrants in said amounts, and to deliver same to said City National Bank upon date of payment of said amount.

## --- AN ORDINANCE---

Appropriating \$60.00 for Special pay rolls from Assessors Office.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$60.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1923 General Fund to meet pay rolls covering special work in City Assessors Office to date, as per pay rolls on file in the office of the City Auditor.

--- RESOLUTION---

DIRECTING the City Purchasing Agent to advertise for bids for Supplies etc. BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City Purchasing Agent be and is hereby directed to advertise for bids for the following:

FIRST: For feeding the prisoners in the city jail for fiscal year 1923.

SECOND: To furnish all City Departments with incandescent lamps for fiscal year 1923.

Third: For supplying the City with gasoline and lubricating oil, for the period beginning July 1st, 1923, and ending December 31st, 1924.

FOURTH: For publishing the official notices of the City in some news paper published in the City, for fiscal year 1923.

AN ORDINANCE.

Appropriating the sum of \$22.25 to pay W. H. Hearne for damage to car caused by hole in the street on Michigan Avenue, April. 12th, 1923.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO: that, the sum of \$22.25 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Street Dept. Fund to pay W. H. Hearne for damage to car caused by the trench on Michigan Ave. not being filled after repairs had been made on the sewer. That a warrant be drawn to pay for said amount and delivered to Mr. Hearne on his executing a proper release for all damage from said accident.

--- AN ORDINANCE---

Repealing a certain ordinance passed and approved on the first day of May, 1922, entitled "An ordinance requiring the San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company, the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company of Texas and C.E. Schaff, receiver of said Railway Company, to construct or cause to be constructed a grade crossing across the tracks of said Railway Companies on Guadalupe Street."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, SECTION ONE: That the ordinance passed and approved on the first day of May, A.D., 1922 and recorded in Minutes Book E, page 132, entitled "An ordinance requiring the San Antonio Belt and Terminal Railway Company, the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company of Texas, and C.E. Schaff receiver of said Company, to construct or cause to be constructed a grade crossing across the tracks of said Railway Companies on Guadalupe Street," be and the same is hereby in all things repealed.

---AN ORDINANCE---

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio: that.

Section 1. That an ordinance passed and approved on August 8, 1921, entitled "Requiring all drafting and construction work to come under the supervision of the City Engineer" recorded in Minute Book "E" page 575 of the proceedings of the Commissioners of said City, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. And be it further ordained by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that an ordinance passed and approved on October 3, 1921, "Requiring all engineering, and all plans and specifications covering all construction work and all employees engaged in engineering, drafting and preparing plans and specifications for construction work, shall come under the direct supervision of the City Engineer, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith, and declaring an emergency; recorded in Minute Book "E" page 623. of the proceedings of the Commissioners of said City, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Commissioner Steffler introduced AN Ordinance permitting G. Sexaner, to construct a Sewer in alley between Hammond Ave. and Drexel Avenue, which was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and public Improvements.
