AN ORDINANCE (2694)

APPROVING AND ACCEPTING AN ASSIGNMENT OF A CONTRACT BY THE SONKEN-GALAMBA CORPORATION TO NATHAN TROTTNER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the City of San Antonio hereby authorizes and approves the assignment of a certain contract entered into by and between the Sonken-Galamba Corporation, a Missouri Corporation, and the City of San Antonio, said contract being manifested by an ordinance passed and approved on May 5, 1938 and entitled "AN ORDINANCE MAKING A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF STEEL RAIL WITH SONKEN-GALAMBA CORPORATION", by the said Sonken-Galamba Corporation to Nathan Trottner, doing business as Trottner Iron and Metal Company, of San Antonio, Texas, hereinafter called Assignee.

2. By said Assignment, it is understood, however, that the said Assignee assumes all obligations and undertakings, as well as the rights and privileges, remaining under contract said Assignee agreeing to complete the performance of said contract in accordance with all its terms and conditions, said Assignee taking over the contract as principal contractor and principal obligor thereunder.

3. The Assignee shall further execute an acceptable performance bond in the amount of \$6,000.00 to secure the performance of the said contract in accordance with its terms and conditions.

AN ORDINANCE (2695)

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO EXECUTE DEED OF CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Mayor of the City of San Antonio be and he is hereby authorized to execute deed of conveyance to the San Antonio Public Service Company, conveying the following described strip and parcel of land, to-wit:

A strip of land running in a southwesterly direction through Block 1572 cutting Lots 10, 9, 8 and 7 the south line of this strip beginning on west P. L. Hallie Street at a point 142.9' north of the S. E. corner of Block 1572 and ending at a point on the north P. L. of Swanee at a point 127.8' west of the S. E. corner of Block 1572, and being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the west property line of Hallie Street at a distance of 142.9' north of the S. E. corner of Block 1572. Thence in a southwesterly direction 191.7' to a point on the north property line of

Swanee Street 127.8' west of the S. E. corner of Block 1572;

Thence continuing west along the north property line of Swanee Street a distance of 66.6' to a point which is 115.6' east of the southwest corner of Block 1572;

Thence in a northeasterly direction parallel to the 50' distant from the first mentioned line a distance of 180.6' to intersect the S. E. property line of the S.A.B. & T. Co. property. This intersection point being 86.6 in a southwesterly direction from the intersection of the S. A. B. & T. Co.'s. S. E. line and the west property line of Hallie Street;

Thence south along the west property line of Hallie Street 76.7' to the place of beginning.

That the consideration for said conveyance, to be recited in said deed, is \$200.00

AN ORDINANCE (2696)

PERMITTING THE CONGREGATION OF THE SISTERS OF CHARITY OF THE INCARNATE WORD, A CORPORATION, TO CONSTRUCT A TUNNEL UNDER WEST TRAVIS STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the Congregation of the Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word, a corporation, be and it is hereby granted a permit to construct and maintain a tunnel under West Travis Street, between Lots 1 and 2, City Block 341 and Lot A-2, City Block 329, and to use the same as a passage under the street in connection with the buildings on its property abutting said street on Lots 1 and 2, City Block 341, on which the Santa Rosa School of Nursing is situated.

2. The licensee, its contractors, servants and agents, shall conform to the blue print attached to this ordinance, and work under the direction of the City Engineer; and, construct and maintain said tunnel in a good and substantial manner; and backfill all excavations, reconstruct sidewalks, street and pavement, in the same manner in which it now is; and, shall obtain all permits and pay all fees required under the ordinances of the City of San Antonio; and make all arrangements with all public service corporations and persons using said street in such manner as to relieve the City of San Antonio from any liability.

3. All of the public utilities of the City of San Antonio shall be re-built, and constructed by the Licensee in such a manner as will not interfere with the use thereof, or impair the services rendered thereby.

4. The grant herein is a permissive easement, and shall never mature, or be construed, as a vested right; and, if ever at any time public necessity requires the regulation, or the revocation of this permit and the abolition of this tunnel, the City of San Antonio, its successors or assigns, shall not be held liable to the licensee, its successors or assigns, for the payment of any sum or sums of money therefor.

5. The City of San Antonio reserves the right to place its pipes, drains, cables and other applicances for public utilities in and across said excavation; and, the licensee

hereby waives all claims for damages that may arise by reason thereof; and, agrees that it will at no time make any claim for damages against the City of San Antonio caused by, through or under this tunnel; and, will protect and hold the City of San Antonio harmless from all damages arising from the construction, the existence or the use of said tunnel, or from the grant herein.

6. The exercise of any right under this permit by the licensee, shall operate as the acceptance of all the terms thereof by all of the parties affected thereby, without further formality.

AN ORDINANCE (2697)

CANCELLING A LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR WEATHER BUREAU OFFICE SPACE AT STINSON FIELD AIRPORT, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A NEW LEASE FOR THE SAME PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio and the United States of America mutually desire the cancellation of a certain lease, dated June 28, 1940, and covering the term beginning July 1, 1940 and ending June 30, 1941, for office space and storage space at Stinson Field Airport; and,

WHEREAS, both parties mutually desire the execution of a new lease for the period beginning January 1, 1941 and ending June 30, 1941, for the same purpose; NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That one certain lease, dated June 28, 1940, entered into by and between the City of San Antonio and the United States of America, for office space and storage space at Stinson Field Airport, to be used by the Weather Bureau of the Department of Agriculture of the United States of America, for the term beginning July 1, 1940 and ending June 30, 1941, for an annual rental of \$360.00, be and the same is hereby in all things terminated as of January 1, 1941.

2. That the Mayor of the City of San Antonio be and he is hereby authorized to execute a lease between the City of San Antonio and the United States of America on Rooms 2, 3, 4 and 8, containing approximately 718 square feet of office space, on the second floor of the Administration Building at Stinson Field Airport; roof space of approximately 500 square feet; ballon shelter of approximately 100 square feet; and steel outbuilding for radioconde work, to be used for office and storage purposes, also by the Weather Bureau of the Department of Agriculture of the United States of America, for the term beginning January 1, 1941 and ending June 30, 1941, for an annual rental of \$600.00, payable at the end of each quarter.

AN ORDINANCE (2768)

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$550,000 MUNICIPAL AIRPORT BONDS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, PROVIDING THE FORM OF BONDS AND INTEREST COUPONS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY, ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST THEREON.

- - -

WHEREAS pursuant to action of this Board of Commissioners and notice given in the manner, time and form required by law, an election was held in the City of San Antonio on January 21, 1941, on the question of whether the Board of Commissioners should be authorized to borrow money on the credit of said City and to issue bonds of said City in the amount of \$550,000 for permanent public improvements, consisting of acquiring and erecting a municipal airport and appurtenances useful and necessary in connection therewith for said City and to acquire land as a site therefore; and

WHEREAS said proposition was approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting at said election who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio:

Section 1. That the negotiable bonds of the City of San Antonio, Texas, to be designated as "Municipal Airport Bonds, 1941," be issued under and by virtue of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of said City of San Antonio, and pursuant to an election duly called and held in said City, in the Amount of \$550,000, for the purpose of acquiring and erecting a municipal airport for said City and acquiring land as a site therefor.

AN ORDINANCE (2766)

GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, WITH CERTAIN RESERVATIONS, AND UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND STIPULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. The Housing Authority of the City of San Antonio, Texas, is hereby granted the right within the boundaries herein designated in the City of San Antonio to lay and maintain pipes underneath, and to string and maintain wires over and along that portion of the public streets, alleys, plazas, squares and creeks, located within the Housing Projects of said Housing Authority described by metes and bounds as follows:

AREA NO. 1

(Tract No. 1). Commencing at the intersection of South Brazos Street and Colima Street; thence west along Colima Street to South San Jacinto Street; thence north along South San Jacinto Street to Montezuma Alley; thence east along Montezuma Alley to South Brazos Street; thence south along South Brazos Street to the place of beginning.

(Tract No. 2). Commencing at the intersection of South San Jacinto Street and Vera Cruz Street; thence west along Vera Cruz Street to a point 366.6 feet west of the west line of South San Jacinto Street; thence north to Colima Street to a point 366.6 feet west of the west line of South San Jacinto Street; thence east along Colima Street to South San Jacinto Street; thence south along South San Jacinto Street to the place of beginning.

(Tract No. 3) Commencing at the intersection of South Brazos Street and Chihuahua Street; thence west along Chihuahua Street to South San Jacinto Street; thence north along South San Jacinto Street to Vera Cruz Street; thence east along Vera Cruz Street to South Brazos Street; thence south along South Brazos Street to the place of beginning.

AREA NO. 2

Commencing at the intersection of Victoria Street and Labor Street; thence southeast to a southern extension of the west line of Peach Street; thence south along a line formed by the west lines of New City Block 2735, Iowa Street, New City Block 641, Virginia Street and New City Block 648, to Leigh Street; thence northwest along Leigh Street to Labor Street; thence north along Labor Street to the intersection of Lavaca Street, extended; thence west along Lavaca Street to a line traversing lot 8, New City Block 708, 10 feet east of the west line of said lot; thence north along said traversing line to Garfield Alley; thence east along Garfield Alley to Labor Street; thence north along Labor Street to the place of beginning.

AREA NO. 3

Commencing at the intersection of North Gevers Street and Harrison Street; thence east along Harrison Street to Hudson Street; thence south along Hudson Street to Hays Street; thence west along Hays Street to North Mittman Street; thence north along North Mittman Street to Arthur Street; thence west along Arthur Street to North Gevers Street; thence north along North Gevers Street to the point of beginning.

AREA NO. 4

Commencing at the intersection of West Poplar Street and North Hamilton Street; thence north along North Hamilton Street to Lombrano Street; thence east along Lombrano Street to a point 336 feet east of the east line of North Elmendorf Street; thence south along a line parallel to the east line of North Elmendorf Street to West Poplar Street at a point 336 feet east of the east line of North Elmendorf Street; thence west along West Poplar Street to the point of beginning.

This franchise shall also include portions of public streets, alleys, plazas, squares and creeks, located between irregular portions of such projects, even though same are not within the projects' boundary lines proper.

2. The purpose of this grant is to authorize said Housing Authority to construct and put in place poles, wires, pipes and other appurtenant equipment for the transmission of gas and electric current into said projects.

3. The gas and electric current purchased by said Housing Authority shall be sold to the tenants on said projects on a non-profit basis.

4. This grant is subject, however, to all legal rights of the owners of land abutting on such streets, alleys, plazas, squares and creeks, and is subject also to the reservations and conditions following.

5. The City Council reserves the right of exclusive control of said streets, alleys, plazas, squares and creeks with the right to direct and c

plazas, squared and creeks with the right to direct and control the location, construction and use of all such poles, wires, pipes and other appurtenant equipment in said streets, alleys plazas, squares and creeks, together with the right to require the location of same to be changed at the expense of said Housing Authority whenever in the judgment of said City Council the public interest or convenience may require such change of location, and whenever, in the judgment of said City Council, such change of location may be necessary to the due accommodation of said Housing Authority's use to which the same are dedicated; which change of location may include the laying of wires underground or a change in the position or location of wires laid underground. When any such change of location may be ordered by said City Council, and is not made by said Housing Authority within 60 days time after receipt of said notice of such order, the change may be made by the City at the expense of said Housing Authority.

6. The franchise hereby granted shall not be transferred, assigned, sold or leased without the consent of the City of San Antonio given by ordinance.

7. The term of this franchise shall be 25 years from the date hereof.

8. Upon the violation by the Housing Authority of any condition in this ordinance, the City Council shall notify said Housing Authority of such violation, and unless the condition be complied with within 60 days after such notice, the said City Council may by ordinance declare the franchise forfeited.

RELEASING SONKEN-GALAMBA CORPORATION FROM FURTHER PERFORMANCE UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE CITY.

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of January, A. WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has, by ordinance passed and approved on the 9th day of January, A. D. 1941 accepted and approved said assignment, and said assignment and extensions thereof are hereby further confirmed and approved, and

WHEREAS, Nathan Trottnner, as sole owner of Trottnner Iron and Metal Company of San Antonio, Texas, has duly executed and furnished the City of San Antonio an acceptable performance bond in the sum of \$6,000.00 to secure his performance of said contract, said bond being dated January 4th, 1941; NOW, THEREFORE:

1. That the bond, dated January 4, 1941, furnished by said Nathan Trottnner as Assignee and Principal and the American Bonding Company of Baltimore, Md. as surety, as accepted and approved the the Mayor of the City of San Antonio, be and the same is hereby accepted in lieu of the performance bond heretofore furnished by Sonken-Galamba Corporation

and its surety the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company, said bond having been dated May 17, 1938.

2. That the said Sonken-Galamba Corporation and its surety be and they are hereby released from further obligation under said original contract dated May 5, 1938, and from any further obligation under the said performance bond dated May 17th, 1938, both of which instruments are referred to above; said bond to be returned upon passage hereof; and that the assignment of said contract and extensions thereof to the said Nathan Trottnner, doing business as sole owner of the Trottnner Iron and Metal Company, be and they are hereby further confirmed approved and accepted.

3. It is understood and agreed that this instrument shall not operate as a release for any violation of the original contract covered by the performance bond dated May 17th, 1938 which may have occurred prior to the date of this ordinance.

AMENDING SECTION 2 OF AN ORDINANCE DATED THE 1ST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1921, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING LOCAL STREET TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS BY JITNEYS, MOTOR BUSES AND OTHER VEHICLES, AND PROHIBITING THE USE OF JITNEYS, MOTOR BUSES AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR SUCH TRANSPORTATION IN THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, EXCEPT AS HEREIN PROVIDED FOR, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES," AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:
