SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN THE CITY MANAGER'S
OFFICE AT 2:00 P.M., TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 23, 1954

The members of the City Council met in the office of the City Manager at the call of the Mayor at 2:00 P.M. for discussion with members of the State Highway Department the matter of proposed routing of U. S. Highway 87 North and its point of interchange with Loop 13.

The whole matter of the history of locating the route was discussed by Mr. F. M. Davis, District Engineer for the Texas Highway Department during which discussion he read to the councilmen who were not members at the time of its passage an excerpt from the minutes of the Highway Department dated June 25, 1952 specifically Minute Order #32277 which was later on July 17, 1952 accepted by the City of San Antonio and on July 9, 1952 by the County of Bexar. He also read to the council a letter which was written by him on November 22, 1954 to the City Manager.

After bringing the council up to date in this matter he went into more detail in discussion with the Council members, all of whom participated in the discussion as did Mr. Bossy, the resident engineer for the State.

Dr. Rice, the City Manager, then addressed the council and called on Mr. Martin, the Planning Director, to go over the details of city planning in the matter. After much discussion and debate, Councilmen Gonzalez and Scherlen left the room and stated that they did not want to make any decision at this time.

An ordinance having been prepared which would set the proposed point of interchange, the Clerk was asked to read it although the council would defer action thereon until the regular council meeting, tomorrow, November 24th.

The members of the council still present then adjourned to the council chamber where the Mayor asked for the roll to be called.

Mr. Dillashaw then asked that the following ordinance be read:

AN ORDINANCE

DESIGNATING THE POINT OF INTERCHANGE BETWEEN
U. S. HIGHWAY 87 NORTH AND LOOP 13

After the reading of the ordinance, Mr. Dillashaw moved that it be laid over until the regular meeting tomorrow, the motion being seconded by Mr. Oliver, carried the following members voting Aye: Oliver, Rudeloff, Dillashaw, White, Lacy, Barrett; No Nays were recorded; Mr. Scherlen, Russell, and Gonzalez being absent.

The Council then adjourned.
