

## SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 31st, A. D. 1924, 4 P. M.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Steffler, Wright. Absent Lambert.

Mayor Tobin, introduced the following ordinance which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.

*MF-1152* AN ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, on October 21, 1924, the City of San Antonio, by deed, recorded in Vol. 789, pages 337 and 338, of the Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas, conveyed to B. Weiss, Lot No. One (1), New City Block No. One Hundred and forty-two (142), on the corner of South Alamo Street and Market Street, more particularly described in said deed of conveyance, and to which reference is here made for more particular described thereof; and,

WHEREAS, at that time said property was, or thereafter would be, subjected to an assessment levy for the widening of Market Street, and part of the consideration for said conveyance was the understanding and agreement on the part of the City of San Antonio that said City would pay such assessment levied against said property, for the widening of Market Street; THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That such assessment levy be and the same is hereby fixed as a charge against the City of San Antonio, and the same be paid in due course, and said B. Weiss be held free and harmless therefrom, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that any other assessments to be made in the future for re-paving, or otherwise, shall be paid by the owners of said property, in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio.

Commissioner Bushick, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.

No. 284 *MF-1153* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$15,375.00 out of Improvement District No. 4 to retire bonds and pay interest coupons.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$15,375.00), be and the same is hereby appropriated out of Sinking Fund, Improvement District No. 4, payable to Texas State Bank and Trust Co., of San Antonio, Texas, for the purpose of retiring Fifteen (15) Bonds Nos. 1 to 15 inc., issued Jan. 1st 1905, maturing January 1st, 1925, of \$1,000.00 each, and to pay 15 interest coupons of above bonds of \$25.00 each being 5% interest for 6 months ending Jan. 1st 1924 amounting to \$375.00.
