

AN ORDINANCE 2010-02-04-0095

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION, AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF UP TO \$250,000.00, UPON AWARD, FROM PETSMART CHARITIES FOR CONTINUATION OF AN INNOVATIVE PET SPAY/NEUTER VOUCHER PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 2010 THROUGH APRIL 2011.**

**WHEREAS**, the City's Strategic Plan states that the City of San Antonio will challenge and lead the community to achieve a "No Kill" goal by 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to achieve the No Kill goal by 2012, a dramatic reduction in the number of stray and homeless animals in the City of San Antonio will be required; and

**WHEREAS**, education and increased accessibility of free and low cost services to the community are key components to achieving this goal; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result, the Animal Care Services Department is requesting authorization to submit a grant application to Petsmart Charities; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded, grant funding will support the continuation of an innovative pet spay/neuter voucher program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the Animal Care Services Department or his designee, is authorized to submit a grant application, and upon award, accept up to \$250,000.00, from Petsmart Charities for continuation of an innovative pet spay/neuter voucher program for the period of February 2010 through April 2011. A copy of said application is on file with the Animal Care Services Department.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of Animal Care Services or his designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said grant application and acceptance of funds.

**SECTION 3.** Should funding be awarded, Fund 26012000 entitled "Misc Grants" is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and the sum of \$250,000.00 from Petsmart Charities will be appropriated in said fund. A formal final budget which will include a department specific fund, an Internal Order number, and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers,






