

January 25, 1955

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN  
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL  
ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 25, 1955, AT 2:00 P.M.

PRESENT: SCHERLEN, OLIVER, RUDELOFF, DILLASHAW, RUSSELL, WHITE, LACY, BARRETT, GONZALEZ

THE Clerk read the call of the meeting.

Mr. Dillashaw, for a committee appointed by the Mayor to investigate the complaint of Dr. G. H. Allen against operation of the dog pound and the rabies control part of the Health Department, reported that the committee had found the complaint ungrounded. Dr. Allen who was present again bitterly attacked the administrator of the pound and vaccination of animals.

After a full discussion, Mr. Barrett moved that in view of the attack made on Dr. Robertson, the rabies control head, and Bexar County Veterinary Association, the council go on record as approving their action and commending this good record made in reducing the incidence of rabies. The motion was adopted by the following vote: AYES, Scherlen, Oliver, Rudeloff, Dillashaw, Russell, White, Lacy, Barrett, Gonzalez. NAYS, none.

The Council next proceeded to the consideration of Zoning Case #400, to rezone a 47 acre tract bounded by Spencer Lane, Kraus Road, Vance Jackson Road and Freiling Drive. This being a continuation of the hearing of January 20th. No one appeared to be heard but the Planning Director, Mr. Winston Martin, for the benefit of the council, presented a chart showing how this tract would be effected by the freeway constructions. The council being convinced that the zoning would not effect the area adversely.

Mr. Rudeloff, seconded by Mr. Dillashaw, moved that the recommendation of the Planning Commission be approved. The motion carried by the following vote: AYES, SCHERLEN, OLIVER, RUDELOFF, DILLASHAW, RUSSELL, WHITE, LACY, BARRETT, GONZALEZ: NAYS, NONE.

THE following ordinance was then presented.

AN ORDINANCE 20,913

AMENDING SECTION 2 OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ETC.," PASSED AND APPROVED ON NOVEMBER 3, 1938, BY CHANGING THE CLASSIFICATION AND RE-ZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED HEREIN: CASE NO. 400, SPENCER LANE, KRAUS ROAD AND VANCE JACKSON ROAD AND FREILING DRIVE

The motion for adoption received the following vote: AYES, Scherlen, Oliver, Rudeloff, Dillashaw, Russell, White, Lacy, Barrett, Gonzalez; NAYS, none.

Mr. Rudeloff now moved that the proposed route of #87 Expressway north as outlined on the map presented to the council by Mr. Martin, <sup>be approved.</sup> after a second by Mr. Dillashaw, the motion carried by the following vote: AYES, Scherlen, Oliver, Rudeloff, Dillashaw, Russell, White, Lacy, Barrett; NAYS, none; NOT VOTING, GONZALEZ. Mr. Russell asked the Clerk to make note of the fact that he voted Aye because of the recommendation of the Planning Commission.

The following ordinance was then presented.

AN ORDINANCE 20,914

AMENDING SECTION 2 OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ETC.," PASSED AND APPROVED ON NOVEMBER 3, 1938, BY CHANGING THE CLASSIFICATION AND RE-ZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED HEREIN: CASE NO. 408, PROPERTY AT S. W. CORNER OF OBLATE AND SAN PEDRO AVENUE, FROM "B" RESIDENCE DISTRICT TO "F" LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT
