

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, APRIL 28th, A.D.1921, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann, Wright.
Absent, Lambert.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

Petition of S.A.Belt and Terminal Railway Company for amendment of certain ordinance relating to erection of Pintsch Gas Plant was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:
