AN ORDINANCE **70790**

ORDERING A SPECIAL ROLLBACK ELECTION TO BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 3, 1990, ON THE QUESTION OF REDUCING THE TAX RATE IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FROM \$0.49415 TO \$0.47701.

WHEREAS, on September 14, 1989, the City Council of the City of San Antonio adopted a tax rate for the current year which exceeded the eight percent rollback tax rate calculated in accordance with Section 26.04, V.T.C.A. Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Clerk on the 13th day of December, 1989, for an election to be held to determine whether or not to reduce the tax rate adopted for the current year; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has verified that the petition was signed by the required number of qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now wishes to act in accordance with law in response to said petition; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of San Antonio finds that the aforesaid petition is valid.

SECTION 2. A special tax rollback election is hereby ordered to be held in the City of San Antonio on Saturday, February 3, 1990, at which time voters shall be permitted to vote for or against the following proposition:

"Reducing the tax rate in the City of San Antonio for the current year from \$0.49415 to \$0.47701."

SECTION 3. Said election shall be held at the polling places in the regularly prescribed voting precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M. The polling place locations are shown in Exhibit A, and the absentee substation voting sites are shown in Exhibit B.

SECTION 4. All qualified electors residing in the City of San Antonio shall be eligible to vote at said election.

SECTION 5. The foregoing proposition shall be submitted on the ballot so that each voter may vote "For" or "Against"; and said ballots shall have written or printed thereon the following:

"Reducing the tax rate in the City of San Antonio for the current year from \$0.49415 to \$0.47701."

SECTION 6. Notice of said election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to law. The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the laws governing such elections.

SECTION 7. The Mayor and City Council shall appoint the election officers to hold said election, in accordance with law, including an Absentee Ballot Board which shall count and canvass the absentee ballots cast at said election.




This certification is made to the facts herein stated only and not as to the legal sufficiency thereof.

Should the rollback petition drive be successful, the City Council will be mandated to call an election. There are definite timing problems with the timetable set out for this particular petition drive and the party primary elections already scheduled.

The City Council, on September 14, 1989, adopted a tax rate exceeding eight percent. According to State law, petitions calling for a rollback election must be submitted on or before the 90th day after the date that the tax rate was adopted. This date is December 13, 1989.

The petitions submitted must be signed by a minimum of ten percent of the registered voters of the City of San Antonio, according to the most recent official voter registration list. This figure is 43,480.


The City has 20 days after receipt of the petitions to determine their validity and pass a resolution stating its findings. This date is January 2, 1990. If the Council fails to act in 20 days, the petitions are deemed valid.

If the petitions are validated, the Council is mandated to order the election to be held not less than 30, (February 1, 1990) nor more than 90 days (April 2, 1990) after the last day on which it could have approved or disapproved the petitions.

The problem facing our City is that the primary elections and run-off elections will be held on March 13 and April 10, 1990, respectively. We have been advised by the Bexar County Elections Administrator that all the voting equipment necessary to hold our City election will be unavailable after February 3, 1990. This is due in great part to the advance lead time needed to prepare and deliver all the machines which will be used for the above stated

elections. Due to the conflicts with the needed equipment, I am proposing that we adopt an accelerated schedule and try to accomplish the verification of these petitions as expeditiously as possible even if it requires the hiring of extra personnel. The election could then be called on December 21, 1989 and held on Saturday, February 3, 1990. I have reviewed all possible alternatives and find that this will be the only date which will enable us to comply with all state requirements and be able to utilize the voting machines needed for the conduct of this election.




