AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE LEASE WITH EDGAR ROGERS AND WIFE, MARINA ROGERS, ON LOTS 1-A and 4-A, COUNTY BLOCK 5742.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

1.
