

AN ORDINANCE      2011-09-15-0764

**AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$102,977.79 TO  
CPS ENERGY FOR UNDERGROUND UTILITY RELOCATION  
SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE SAN ANTONIO RIVER  
WATER TREATMENT FACILITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio River Water Treatment Project was originally adopted as part of the FY 2007-2012 Capital Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, this facility will be located in Brackenridge Park and will disinfect water flows discharging into the San Antonio River from the San Antonio Zoo outfall through a UV facility; and

**WHEREAS**, this project is one of the most important components of the San Antonio River Watershed Protection Plan that is supported by the Bexar Regional Watershed Management group; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes payment by the City of San Antonio to CPS Energy for the relocation of an underground electrical utility at the proposed location of the UV facility near Brackenridge Park; and

**WHEREAS**, this is a one-time capital expenditure in the amount of \$102,977.79 for underground utility relocation for which funds are available from previously authorized Certificates of Obligations, Storm Water Revenue Bonds, and Storm Water Operating Funds and included in the FY 2011-2016 Capital Budget, **NOW THEREFORE**;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, the Assistant City Manager, or an Assistant to the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance memorializing the relocation work to be performed by CPS Energy for relocation of an underground electrical utility at the proposed location of the UV facility near Brackenridge Park.

**SECTION 2.** Payment in the amount not to exceed \$102,977.79 in SAP Fund 43099000, Certificates of Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 26-00519, San Antonio River Water Treatment, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **CPS Energy** for the relocation of an underground utility.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.

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


