

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO SEPTEMBER 27TH, 1915,  
AT FOUR O'CLOCK, P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland Lambert Kearny and Steves.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

- - - - - MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS - - - - -

The petition of the Jitney Automobile Service Association relating to transfer of license, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Taxation, Garland.

The petition of the Southern Ice & Cold Storage Company, for permit to sublet part of room leased by it in Mahncke Court, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation, Lambert.

The petition of of citizens for water main in South Zarzamora Street, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation, Lambert.

The petition of Dalkowitz Bros for permit to construct a concrete slab over area at the intersection of Commerce & N. Flores Streets, was read and referred to the City Engineer and Building Inspector.

The petition of M. J. Kline, proposing to convey land to City for Street Purposes was read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements, Kearny.

Commissioner Lambert's motion that the petition of Dalkowitz Bros Company for permit to use space under sidewalk on Military Plaza be not granted until the petitioners sign up for paving to be constructed in front of their property was carried on roll-call by the following vote, to-wit: <sup>Ayes,</sup> Brown, Garland, Lambert Kearny and Steves.

Commissioner of Taxation, Garland, recommended that the petition of Lenora Tilford Worley, for reduction of assessment, be not granted. Adopted.
