

AN ORDINANCE 2013-06-20-0459

**AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITY COUNCIL PROJECT FUNDS IN A CUMULATIVE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000.00 FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH DESTINATION COLLEGE.**

**WHEREAS**, the adopted FY 2013 budget provides for individual City Council district discretionary funds, commonly referred to as City Council Project Funds (CCPF) for programs, activities, events, scholarships, goods, or services that promote specified municipal public purposes set out in guidelines approved by City Council pursuant to Ordinance 2011-12-08-1011 approved on December 8, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, P16Plus Council of Greater Bexar County has submitted an application for CCPF allocation for expenses incurred in connection with Destination College, an initiative held April 27 – May 4, 2013 aimed at helping San Antonio achieve its 2020 goal of 50% college completion; and

**WHEREAS**, this initiative meets the objectives of the Ordinance and it is the desire of City Council to support the applicant’s request; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** City Council Project Fund grants allocations to the following vendors and organizations in the approximate amounts described below, are hereby approved.

This allocation is made possible through CCPF contributions made by the Office of the Mayor. The cumulative amount paid under the authority of this Ordinance shall not exceed \$40,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** Funding in the amount of \$40,000.00 for this Ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 7004110001 and General Ledger 5201040, as part of the Fiscal Year 2013 Budget. Expenses identified in Section 1 above total \$29,612.39. The balance of funds shall be available to pay invoices submitted by other vendors and organizations, as approved by the Assistant to City Council, Mayor and Council Support.

**SECTION 3.** Payments not to exceed the budgeted amount are authorized to various vendors and organizations in support of Destination College and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

**SECTION 4:** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.






