Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:
Petition of Thrall Oil and Refining Co. for permit to erect storage tanks at Vera Cruz St. and I. & G. N. tracks.

R.Pace, for permit to install gasoline tank etc. 208 S. Pecos St.

Travis Tire Service, for permit to install gasoline tank and pump, 207 E.Travis Street.

No. 382 **-824** AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing refund of \$44.69 to San Antonio Drug Company.

Pruitt Commission Company, for permit to install gasoline tank at Monterey and Medina Streets be granted. Adopted.


